Intersection with CalAIM Goals



- Funding will help to enhance access to services and supports needed for older adults, persons with disabilities, caregivers, people with developmental disabilities, behavioral health needs, and those experiencing homelessness
- Addresses health equity & disparities
- Expansion of Medi-Cal to approximately 27,000 undocumented adults age 50+
- Support CBOs
 - Infrastructure
 - Capacity Building
 - Training
- Data Sharing
- Addition of 7,000 ALW slots
- Addresses fragmented health care & Long-Term Supports Services (LTSS)

- Engage stakeholders & expand involvement, including MCP Members
- Leverage resources to build out local-level master plans on aging
- Personal care and other staff competencies & training
- Use of technology in care management models
- Expansion of Alzheimer's day care & resource centers, especially in underserved areas
- Street medicine models
- Further strengthening of partnerships with the counties and improved coordination of services thru the Housing & Homeless Incentive Program (HHIP)
