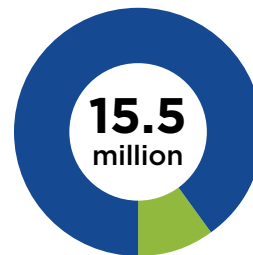
With more than 15 million enrollees, California's Medicaid program (Medi-Cal) provides comprehensive medical, behavioral, and mental health care benefits and services to one in three Californians. Within Medi-Cal, an estimated 14.1 million members are enrolled in Medi-Cal Managed Care, providing some of California's most vulnerable populations with well-rounded services for improved health outcomes.

Medi-Cal Managed Care: Providing quality health care throughout California

Medi-Cal Managed Care Oversight

The Department of Health Care Services (DHCS) administers and oversees the Medi-Cal program while the Department of Managed Health Care (DMHC) licenses and regulates most Medi-Cal Managed Care plans. The State of California relies on Managed Care plans to provide comprehensive health coverage to 14.1 million Californians, or 4 out of 5 Medi-Cal enrollees. Consumers face no out-of-pocket costs, and most pay no monthly premiums. Medi-Cal rates are set by the state and must be certified by independent actuaries and reviewed and approved by the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS). Medi-Cal Managed Care plans must meet an 85% medical loss ratio (MLR) for their expansion populations.

Medi-Cal Managed Care Health Plan Choices by County

Managed Care is available in all 58 counties, including rural areas, and most seniors and persons with disabilities are enrolled in Managed Care. Counties follow one of several models – county organized health systems, geographic managed care (GMC), two-plan, regional, and models specific to Imperial and San Benito counties.
